



Hi Incoming 6th Grade Families!

I hope you are all having a good summer and have had a chance to turn off your devices and enjoy the outdoors these past couple weeks!

Typically we have middle school students work on a certain amount of KhanAcademy over the summer to keep their math skills sharp. Given that students spent so much time on devices over the last couple months, I'm providing a PDF packet for them to complete this summer. Students should spend at least 30 minutes a week on math to ensure they retain the content and are prepared for 6th grade. All work should be shown on the page or neatly, labeled clearly on a separate piece of paper. They are required to complete the packet and return it with any separate work papers to school on the first day of classes.

Mrs. Prunier will be able to print the packet for any parents that don't have access to a printer at home. To request a packet, please email her at office@blessedsacrament.org. When you email her please provide the grade you are looking for (incoming 6th grade), your student's name, and your address for her to send it to.

If your student completes the packet and you are still looking to keep their math skills sharp as a tack, they can work on Khan Academy. I've created a Khan Academy class they can access by using this link: <https://www.khanacademy.org/join/5HT494XZ>. Please email me when they join, so that I can officially add them to the roster. On Khan Academy, they will be assigned mastery of the 5th grade standards. Khan Academy is not required, but highly recommended. As mentioned, students should be completing at least 30 minutes of math a week to prepare for 6th grade.
