

# 6th Grade Supply List

2020-2021 Updated 8.28.20

**General Supplies:** *This year all students will be required to have their own personal supplies at their desk. No supplies will be shared in classrooms. We will update this list closer to the start of the school year with specifics about what to bring to school and when. But anticipate keeping some supplies at home to be replenished as needed. LABEL EVERYTHING with a Sharpie!*

- 18 - 25 gallon plastic bin in lieu of lockers this year (fits jacket, lunch, books, binders, etc.)
- Yoga mat or beach towel (will be used for sitting outdoors)
- 2 personal face-masks (minimum)
- 1-2 pencil cases (soft-sided, not a box)
- Earbuds or headphones (each student is required to have their own pair)
- optional: Stylus or Apple Pencil
- 1 package of fine tip (not ultra fine tip) dry-erase markers
- 1 package 8 fine tip washable markers
- 1 package colored pencils
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 bottle of white-out
- Scissors (small)
- 1 box dark blue or black pens
- 1 box red pens
- 3 boxes pencils
- 2 block erasers
- 4 pack assorted color highlighters
- 4 packs of loose-leaf paper (college-ruled)
- Handheld pencil sharpener
- Personal stapler
- Personal hole punch (One that connects to binder is recommended.)
- 1 scotch tape dispenser
- Composition Notebook to be used as reflection journal

### Health Safety Supplies for Classrooms:

- 4 large boxes of tissues
- 1 large container of disinfectant cleaning wipes
- 1 antibacterial hand sanitizer gel (16 oz or larger) \*above 60% ethanol or 70% isopropanol alcohol and is not on the recall list.
- 2 large roll of paper towels (1 Roll for STEM Class)
- Personal safety eye goggles for STEM laboratories

### Personal materials should be organized as follows:

- Pencil Case 1: 3-5 dark pens, 2 red pen, 3 pencils, highlighters (1 blue, 1 pink, 1 yellow, 1 green), 1 eraser, pencil sharpener, earbuds,
- Pencil Case 2: small scissors, 1 glue stick, 1 white out, colored pencils, markers (removed from packaging - can use an elastic to contain), small stapler, scotch tape

### Individual Subject Supplies:

ELA	One Three-ring binder with the student's name on the outside One package of 5 tab dividers with insert labels for a three ring binder One package of college-ruled three-hole paper One two-pocket folder with the student's name on the outside Two packages of 2x2 Post-It (or similar) notes One package of 3x5 index cards
Math	TX30-IIS scientific calculator - no graphing calculators, 2" binder, 5 dividers for binder - no pockets, spiral bound graph paper notebook, 1 subject spiral notebook with perforated paper, 12 inch clear ruler with in & cm
STEM	1" binder, 1 subject spiral notebook, 5 dividers for binder - no pockets in dividers
Social Studies	1-Subject Spiral Notebook, Pocket Folder, 1 Package of 3x5 index cards
Theology	1-THREE subject Spiral Notebook for Theology only, 1 Pocket Folder (Recommended: CATHOLIC NAB Bible for home use)
Spanish	Wide-ruled composition notebook with a cardboard cover (not a flexible plastic cover), pocket folder, 1 pack of stickable filing tabs (made by post-it or other similar), 2 packs of 3x5 index cards, 1 Spanish/English Dictionary (paperback), 1 pack of index card rings (can be found at the dollar tree), 1 pack of construction paper

**Personal Technology Requirements:**

Students using a BSS issued iPad will receive it with a dictionary, a Spanish dictionary, a Bible, and an assignment calendar on it. Students using their own iPad will be given a list of *specific* apps and resources to load before school starts.

Students should have access to a computer and a working printer at home. Each student is responsible for printing their own assignments.
