Recognizing the important partnership that exists between school, home and church, Blessed Sacrament School seeks to support families that are active in the life of their home parish community. Families that submit this form are eligible for financial assistance from the archdiocesan school tax funds received by BSS. Families must also share the “Parish Assistance - Pastor Form” with their pastor, so that he can complete it and send it back to BSS. This process replaces the parish sponsorship program that had previously been used at BSS, in response to changes to the school tax policy at the Archdiocesan level.
