

6th Grade Supply List

2022-2023

General Supplies: *Each academic class has an assigned color for notebooks, binders, and/or folders to help students stay organized throughout their school day. You will find the colors listed next to each class in the table below. While it is not required, we do recommend that students follow this system as closely as inventory in stores will allow. Please anticipate keeping some supplies at home to be replenished as needed. Please LABEL EVERYTHING with a Sharpie!*

- 1-2 pencil cases (soft-sided, not a box)
- Earbuds or headphones (each student is required to have their own pair)
- 1 package 8 fine tip washable markers
- 1 package colored pencils
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 bottle of white-out
- Scissors (small)
- 2 boxes dark blue or black pens (erasable is ok)
- 1 box red pens
- 2 boxes of pencils
- 2 block erasers
- 4 pack assorted color highlighters
- Suggested:
 - Handheld pencil sharpener
 - Personal stapler
 - Personal hole punch (One that connects to a binder is recommended.)
 - 1 scotch tape dispenser

Health Safety Supplies for Classrooms:

- 4 large boxes of tissues
- 1 large container of disinfectant cleaning wipes
- 4 large roll of paper towels

Personal materials should be organized as follows:

- Pencil Case 1: 3-5 dark pens, 2 red pen, 3 sharpened pencils, highlighters (1 blue, 1 pink, 1 yellow, 1 green), 1 block eraser, pencil sharpener, earbuds,

- Pencil Case 2: small scissors, 1 glue stick, 1 white out, colored pencils, markers (removed from packaging - can use an elastic to contain), small stapler, scotch tape

ELA (Yellow)	<p>One 1.5-inch three-ring binder with the student's name on the outside</p> <p>One package of 5 tab dividers for a three ring binder with tab inserts</p> <p>One package of college-ruled three-hole paper</p> <p>One composition notebook (100 sheets) for advisory sessions, etc.</p> <p>Note: After school begins, the novels used in class will be purchased for each student, and the cost of the books will be charged to your FACTS account.</p>
Math (Blue)	<p>1.5" binder with 5 dividers for binder - no pockets'</p> <p>1 subject graph paper spiral notebook with perforated edge</p> <p>12 inch clear (can be colored) ruler with in & cm</p> <p>1 box of pencils to leave in classroom</p>
STEM (Purple)	<p>One 3 inch Three-ring binder with the student's name on the outside</p> <p>5 dividers for binder - no pockets in dividers</p> <p>College ruled lined loose paper (put in binder)</p> <p>Graph paper (put in binder)</p> <p>Scissors, One pack of colored pencils, Ruler, Glue Stick</p>
Social Studies (Red)	<p>1-Subject Spiral Notebook, Pocket Folder, 1 Package of 3x5 index cards, one pack of colored pencils</p>
Theology (White)	<p>One 1 inch 3-ring binder. 1 composition book/journal to use for Theology only..</p>
Spanish (Green)	<p>One WIDE-RULED composition notebook with marble cover</p> <p>One 1.5 inch 3-ring binder</p> <p>One package of 5 tab binder dividers</p> <p>One pack of WIDE-RULED filler paper</p> <p>2 packs of 3x5 index cards</p> <p>1 pack of silver binder rings (can be found at the dollar tree)</p> <p>4 elmer's glue sticks</p>
